



EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN TRAINING PROGRAM

Purpose of Program:

The purpose of this program is to train Emergency Medical Technicians who provide emergency care to people outside of or on the way to the hospital. They can give basic medical and first-aid care until a person can get help at a hospital or other medical facility. Emergency medical technicians assess, treat and manage service users at the scene, reducing the need for them to be admitted to hospital if it is appropriate to do so, by either referring service users to alternative care provisions or safely discharging them on scene.

Duration of Program:

Program consists of 550 hours of theoretical training. (250 hours – offline, 300 hours of -face-to-face trainings). Program also includes 450 hours of practical training which consists of 150 hours of simulation and laboratories and 300 hours of observation.
